Dear Glinton Parish Council,

I am writing to request consideration for a grant for 1st Glinton Rainbows to help reduce the financial impact of the introduction of the new Girlguiding Programme in September.

The new programme requires an initial outlay in expenditure for compulsory activity packs (@£2.50 per pack) and also badge books (@£6 per book) for the current cohort of Rainbows. Unfortunately, this will impact on our current financial situation quite significantly. It will not only reduce the funds that we have currently allocated to spend on activities with the Rainbows but also the community activities that we plan to undertake, for example the Christmas Tree Festival and Christmas Tree Light Switch On later in the year.

Your support with these initial outlay costs would mean that I would not have to increase the termly subscription that the parents currently pay for their daughter's attendance, which means that Rainbows will continue to be accessible by all families regardless of their income status.

I appreciate that you kindly gave us a grant last year to specifically purchase resources for the unit and will obviously understand if there is a time limit for repeat applications which means that we are not yet eligible.

Regardless of your decision, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for considering the application and your continued support of our Rainbow group.
