Dear Counsellor Holdich

I am emailing to request the removal of the tree located directly in front of my house [12 Beech Road](#), Glington. It is a large tree and when the berries begin to drop from the tree it becomes very dangerous on the path below. I regularly go and sweep them away but they are often squashed creating a slip hazard. As the berries begin to rot they also smell and attract wasps and other insects. When it rains this area becomes even more dangerous. I have many elderly neighbours and have 3 small children myself, I am very worried that an accident is certain to happen soon. I have raised my concern with a local Parrish council member who is in agreement that the tree needs to be removed. I would ask that you kindly consider my request and let me know if your decision.
