Dear Cllr Holdich,

Rob has asked me to come back to you with some details of additional support we could offer for the schools in Glington.

The parking enforcement team work shifts 8am-4pm or 12pm-8pm, with the 8am-4pm shift responsible for the school enforcement program. Schools on our enforcement program are visited on rotation, however due to the number of schools requiring attention and the number of officers available to us the frequency is often only once every other week. We will do one-off weeks of action, focusing solely on one problem school every day of the week - we have done this for Arthur Mellows before and could do so again after half term if required.

If you wanted more regular visits and if funding was provided we could offer out overtime for officers on the 12-8 shift to come in and do schools in the morning before their shift starts, however I am not convinced there would be much uptake of this. Officers can walk in excess of 12 miles in a shift and so the offer of a split shift might not be that appealing. The cost to us for overtime would be £17.67 an hour and I would expect 1.5hrs would be required to get an officer in, kitted up and to the schools in Glington and back. If you would like to explore this option please let me or Rob know and I will see if there are any volunteers.
