Good Morning Gerry

Thank you for your email enquiry.

We manufacture all these seats from steel, hot dip galvanize for weather and corrosion protection, then paint in 2 pack acrylic paint in your colour of choice. They are all come with our lifetime guarantee.

The seat backs themselves are 6mm thick making them almost indestructible, over a thousand of these seats we have only ever had 1 incident of malicious vandalism where someone took a grinder to a seat and cut out the poppies, presumably for their own living room! Unfortunately this kind of vandalism is unavoidable and apart from this our seats are considered as near to vandal proof as anyone could expect.

It is possible to have the back laser cut thicker but this would significantly increase the price of the seat but should there still be a concern we could attached a galvanized steel, painted sheet to the back of the seat as a cheaper alternative, I have attached a picture of this for your review.

Price for our WW1 seat is £647 +VAT each +Delivery.
Price for an additional steel backing plate is £100 +VAT.
