Re: Peterborough Local Plan Proposed Submission Consultation, 8 January to 20 February 2018

I am writing to inform you that Peterborough City Council (PCC) is consulting on the latest version of the Peterborough Local Plan, known as the Proposed Submission Local Plan. This consultation is undertaken under Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. Separately, but linked, PCC is also consulting on a Sustainability Appraisal of the Proposed Submission Local Plan.

You have received this notification because you are classed as an agent and have:

- made comments on earlier drafts of the Local Plan on behalf of a client; or
- you are a person or body which has requested to be informed; or
- you are a body whom we are obliged to inform.

Full details of the consultation are set out in the Statement of Representations Procedure below and on our website at: <https://www.peterborough.gov.uk/council/planning-and-development/planning-policies/new-local-plan/>.

Please note that this consultation stage is different to earlier consultation stages. Therefore, if you are not familiar with this stage of the consultation process, before making any comments please read the guidance note available on our website which explains how to make comments and how any comments will be dealt with.

Once the consultation period ends, all representations (comments) received during the 8 January to 20 February 2018 consultation period will be submitted by the Council to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, who will subsequently appoint an Inspector to hold an 'Examination' into the soundness of the Plan. If you do make comments, they will be considered by the Inspector (not by the Council) and you may be asked by the Inspector whether you wish to also appear at a Public Examination. You will not be obliged to attend.

If you make representations (other than online) it would be extremely helpful if you use or refer to your Person ID, if you have one (see top of this letter). May I advise you that representations will not be kept confidential and will be made available to the public (including online).

If you no longer wish to be kept informed on the Local Plan and other planning policy matters for Peterborough, please let us know - we do not want to contact you unnecessarily.
