### Notes from Meeting with Andrew Jacobs re Permissive Paths

Date: 23 January 2017 at Peakirk Village Hall

#### Details

AJ is still having problems with vandalism of the old shed, dog walkers leaving bags near the shed and at the crossing, walkers deviating from the path around Betty's Wood and walkers waling in the field east of the northern end of the tree belt.

It was agreed that Glinton and Peakirk would produce a leaflet to inform and educate people about the use of the permissive paths, including:

- Bag it, bin it
- It's a footpath not a cycle path
- A map showing the paths
- An explanation of what a permissive path is
- Working farm with associated agricultural activities

The leaflet is to be delivered to all houses in Glinton & Peakirk. Extra copies to be available to be given out as necessary.

A3 signs will also be produced to be put at the ends of the paths.

The possibility of creating steps up the bank at the northern end of the tree belt path will be investigated.
