The application should have been accompanied by the fee of £140 and I would be grateful if this could be forwarded to me.


The drawings as submitted do not show the proposed Lorry and Van designs, although reference is made to the size of "designs Top Corners 7" x 3"

The size appears to be almost twice the size of the bronze framed photograph (4.25" x 3.75")

Please could you confirm these designs are still required. If so it would be helpful to councillors to have these included in a drawing. I say this as the reasons for refusal, when last considered, included the point that councillors were unable to visualise the impact of these designs which are unusual.

I will place the application on the agenda for the next meeting with the existing drawing, or whatever is in my possession by that date. This will be considered by the parish council on Tuesday 20th February.

Dear Mr Cross,
The application for the memorial headstone for J A Goodman, plot 105, Bay 5, Lawn Cemetery Glinton was considered by the parish council on Tuesday evening.

Parish council regulations stipulate the maximum size of memorials. Regulations also stipulate that applications for permission to erect a memorial should be accompanied by a drawing of the proposed layout of the headstone.

In the absence of scaled drawings the Parish council were unable to visualise the scale of the photograph and engraved car and Lorry in relation to the wording. In addition there are no other headstones in the Lawn cemetery with wording on the back and parish council were unable to visualise the scale of the proposed heart and words in relation to the size of the headstone.

The application is therefore refused

Please resubmit an application for a memorial headstone within regulation size, accompanied by a scaled drawing showing both the front and rear of the headstone. Payment of the relevant fee should also be made at the time of the revised application.
