

Peterborough Rural crime and information update – 1st to 28th November 2016

Please find enclosed reported crime and incidents of note during the month of November 2016. This report is intended to inform Parish Councils and their communities of issues they should be aware of and will not include incidents such as domestic violence or personal assault for example.

Northborough Ward (crimes and incidents of note)

- **Marholm, Woodcroft Rd – 3rd Nov** - Theft from motor vehicle - unknown offenders have stolen fuel from unlocked Fuel Tank on Van.
- **Etton, Main Road – 2 to 4 Nov** – Theft - Unknown suspects have stolen tools from where work is being carried out at the Roadside.
- **Etton, Main Road – 22nd Nov** – Attempt Burglary – Unknown offender has tried to force back door and window with blunt instrument. No entry gained and nothing stolen.
- **Northborough, Granville Ave – 10th to 11th Nov** - Theft from dwelling – Item left on side in the Kitchen have been stolen.

Glington and Wittering Ward (crimes and incidents of note)

- **Ailsworth, Helpston Rd – 11th Nov** – Theft from motor vehicle – front window smashed and items stolen.

- **Sutton, Graeme Rd – Overnight 23/24 Nov** – Interference with a motor vehicle – Locks removed and door damaged.
- **Thornhaugh, Meadow Lane – overnight 7/8 Nov** – Theft – Cast-iron planters taken from open porch overnight.

Eye and Thorney Ward (crimes and incidents of note reported)

- **Eye, Peterborough Rd** – 1st Nov - Theft of motor vehicle – iron gates removed and quad bike stolen. Recovered by Police later.
- **Eye, Eyebury Rd** – 5th Nov - Theft – Tile cutter stolen from front garden.
- **Eye, Eyebury Rd** – overnight 11/12 Nov – Theft from motor vehicle – Front and Rear index plates stolen from car.
- **Eye, Northey Rd** – overnight 10/12 Nov – Criminal Damage – Unknown suspect has caused extensive damage to aviary door which has then been left open and approx. 15 birds have flown from enclosure
- **Eye, Thorney Rd** – overnight 13/14 Nov – Theft – Chain cut on metal gate and entry gained to building site. Tools stolen. .
- **Eye, Woburn Drive** – overnight 11/14 Nov – Theft – Diesel engine stolen from building site.
- **Eye, Thorney Rd** – 14/15th Nov – Theft – Mess front section stolen from dog kennels.
- **Eye, High Street** – 10th Nov – Theft from motor vehicle – male seen on CCTV outside Co-Op smash car window with elbow and grab bag from foot well of vehicle.
- **Eye, Thorney Rd** -15th Nov – Dwelling Burglary – Power tools stolen from house under refurbishment.
- **Eye, Easby Rise** – 16th to 18th Nov – Dwelling Burglary – Entry via rear patio door, TV stolen.
- **Eye, Eyebury Rd** – 17th Nov – Unknown how entry has been gained – TV and Jewellery Box stolen.
- **Eye, Whitby Ave** – 21st Nov – Criminal Damage to a dwelling. Side window smashed by unknown means.
- **Eye, Westminster Gardens**– 21/22 Nov - Theft from motor vehicle – Items stolen from insecure vehicle parked overnight.
- **Eye, Bath Rd**– 22nd Nov – Theft of motor vehicle – VW golf left locked and secured. Stolen from parking space overnight.
