A mother has written to Cllr Holdich / Hiller to ask about the 'no ball signs' on the green area between Beech Rd and the start of Elm Crescent. Her children were playing football on the green but were asked to stop by a resident who pointed out the signs to them. She has asked if this signage could be removed.

This area is not a 'playing field' as such and is flanked by roads. I suspect signs were originally motivated by road safety concerns as this is not an ideal place to play football given it being so close to the road and houses.

The signs are advisable only and not enforceable. I am unsure of the background but they may be something the Parish arranged?

I think this is best considered locally given the divisive nature....**Would you be able to bring this request for the removal to the attention of the Parish Council?**
