Please find enclosed reported crime and incidents of note during the month of January 2018. This report is intended to inform Parish Councils and their communities of issues they should be aware of and will not include incidents such as domestic violence, shoplifting or personal assault for example.

Deeping Gate, Etton, Maxey, Northborough (crimes and incidents of note)
