Please find enclosed reported crime and incidents of note during the month of February 2018. This report is intended to inform Parish Councils and their communities of issues they should be aware of and will not include incidents such as domestic violence, shoplifting or personal assault for example.

Deeping Gate, Etton, Maxey, Northborough

- Northborough, Granville Avenue 20-21/2: TFMV tools stolen from work van.
- Maxey, High St 21/2: TFMV 3 males were seen to steal tools from a van at 4am and leave the scene in a dark coloured saloon vehicle possibly a Volvo.
- Deeping Gate, Peakirk Road 25/2: TFMV index plates stolen

- Ailsworth, Casworth Way 7/2: Burglary where offenders entered via rear patio doors.

 Officer from London. This was a Courier Fraud Scam and we have been raising awareness of this scam for
 some time. Please do not give any bank details to anyone over the phone and the Police will NEVER ask for
 this information.

Eye and Thorney

- Thorney, English Drove 6-7/2: Business burglary where offenders forced entry to some porta cabins and on 10-12/2 fuel was syphoned from three vehicles.
- Eye, Little Close 17-18/2: Burglary via forced rear door
- Eye, Thorney Rd 18-20/2: Business burglary where electrical items were stolen. Offenders gained entry via a rear door to the premises.
- Thorney, Station Rd 20-21/2: Burglary rear door forced by offenders. A dark coloured vehicle was seen reversing at around 2.30pm possibly a Skoda Fabia.
- Thorney, St Marys Close 14-15/2: TFMV tools stolen.
- Eye, The Crescent 23/2: Fraud (Courier Fraud call as per above). No information was given as the resident realised this was a scam call.
