

Peterborough Rural crime and information update – 1st to 31st October 2016

Please find enclosed reported crime and incidents of note during the period 1st- 31st October 2016. This report is intended to inform Parish Councils and their communities of issues they should be aware of and will not include incidents such as domestic violence or personal assault for example.

Firstly may I introduce myself as the new Crime Reduction Office for your area. I only started my new role on 24th October, but I have worked for the force for 22 years in various different roles and am looking forward to getting to know you all over the coming months.

This month has seen the Rural Crime Team working on their Priorities of Theft of Lead and Hare Coursing all in rural areas.

Northborough Ward (crimes and incidents of note)

- **Deeping Gate** – 5th Oct - theft of boat – Riverside – unknown offenders took boat from river at rear of garden.
- **Deeping Gate** – 5th Oct - theft of lead – Peakirk Road – unknown offenders have taken lead from roof of isolated dwelling.
- **Etton** – 8th Oct – Burglary non dwelling – Main Road – unknown offenders have forced padlocks on barn door and stolen tools.
- **Etton** – overnight 25/26 Oct – Burglary non dwelling – Rectory Lane - Offenders have forced entry to a barn and stolen numerous cycles, tools and garden equipment.
- **Northborough** – 20th Oct - theft from motor vehicle– Granville Ave – overnight both index plates have been unscrewed and stolen from vehicle parked on driveway.

Glington and Wittering Ward (crimes and incidents of note)

- **Ailsworth** – 1st Oct– Theft from motor vehicle – Helpston Rd near nature reserve – whilst walking dogs, rear window smashed and portable dvd player stolen.

- **Ailsworth** – overnight 23/24 Oct – Holme Close – Overnight offenders have forced double garage and various sports and fishing equipment stolen.

Barnack Ward (crimes and incidents of note reported)

- **Barnack** – Theft from motor vehicle – Wittering Rd - 2nd Oct – Rear window smashed and bag grabbed from seat.
- **Barnack** – Theft of Diesel Bowse – Walcot Rd – Overnight 16/17 Oct – stolen from field during hours of darkness.

- **Eye** – 3rd Oct - Dwelling Burglary in Deerhurst Way. Offender smashed rear window, untidy search and numerous small electrical items stolen.
- **Eye** – overnight 6th Oct in Bath Rd – Dwelling Burglary – Occupants sleeping upstairs, unknown point of entry, numerous doors left open by offender. Various items stolen including index plates off car parked on driveway.

- **Eye** – overnight 6th Oct – theft from vehicle reported on Peterborough Road – tools and computer stolen.
- **Eye** – between 21:30-21:58 on 9th Oct – Robbery – Peterborough Road – Offender knocked victim to floor in an attempt to steal handbag. Offender cycled off empty handed. CF0455171016 refers.
- **Eye** – 16th Oct – Burglary – Merevale Drive – Offenders entered property via insecure door, stolen car keys and taken car from driveway.
- **Eye** – 16th Oct – Bath RD – Theft of bike from unlocked garage.
- **Eye** – Overnight 15/16 Oct – Millport Drive – Theft of index plates from car parked on driveway.
- **Eye** – 14th Oct – White Post Rd – Arson – 100 Tonnes of Hay Bales set on fire.
- **Eye** – 23rd Oct – Merevale Drive – Theft of motor vehicle
- **Eye** – 22/24th Oct – Thorney Rd – Building plot under construction – UPVC patio door forced and flat packed kitchen and electrical items stolen from inside on of the rooms on the plot.
- **Eye** – 26/27th Oct – Merevale Drive – Criminal Damage – Electric box on side of the house has been damaged.
- **Eye** – 27/28 Oct – Little Close – Criminal Damage – Graffiti on rear wooden fence.
- **Eye** – 30th Oct – Thorney Road – Dwelling Burglary – Entry gained to caravan by smashing a side window, entry gained and drawers opened, jewellery stolen.

- **Thorney** – between 7th and 10th Oct – Burglary (non dwelling) at French Drove. Lock has been cut on storage container and a high value of power tools were taken.
- **Thorney** – Willow Hall Lane – 11th Oct – Theft of pedal cycle
- **Thorney** – Orchard Court – 13th Oct – bolt cut on garage door and entry gained, property search but nothing appears stolen.
- **Thorney** – Orchard Court – 14th Oct – bolt cut on garage door and replaced with their own padlock
