John.following our recent emailed correspondance,I am reiterating my proposal for additional parking for visitors adjacent to my property at the above address.

As I mentioned to you before I am seeking formal permission to convert a current grass verge to a gravelled area for approx 2 vehicles which would act as a temporary visitor parking for nearby properties as well as on occasion parents of Arthur Mellows school.

My intention,if possible is to extend the current gravel driveway which comes off Helpston Rd which serves only 2 properties (nos 27 & 29) and is a dead end with existing short concrete bollards.

I am fully aware of the cost implications for the council,so I am willing to pay for this to be done using a local landscaping company who will achieve the same standard of work as your own council contractors if that is satisfactory.

I feel this will not be detrimental to the look of that particular area in question,but ultimately achieve a better finished effect because the churned up grass/mud will be eradicated for good.

I like to take pride in the look of the village even though its minimal to the passer by,but I feel this is important to a picturesque place to live.

I have supplied a sketch of the area in question for reference,but I understand you would need to visit the said area .

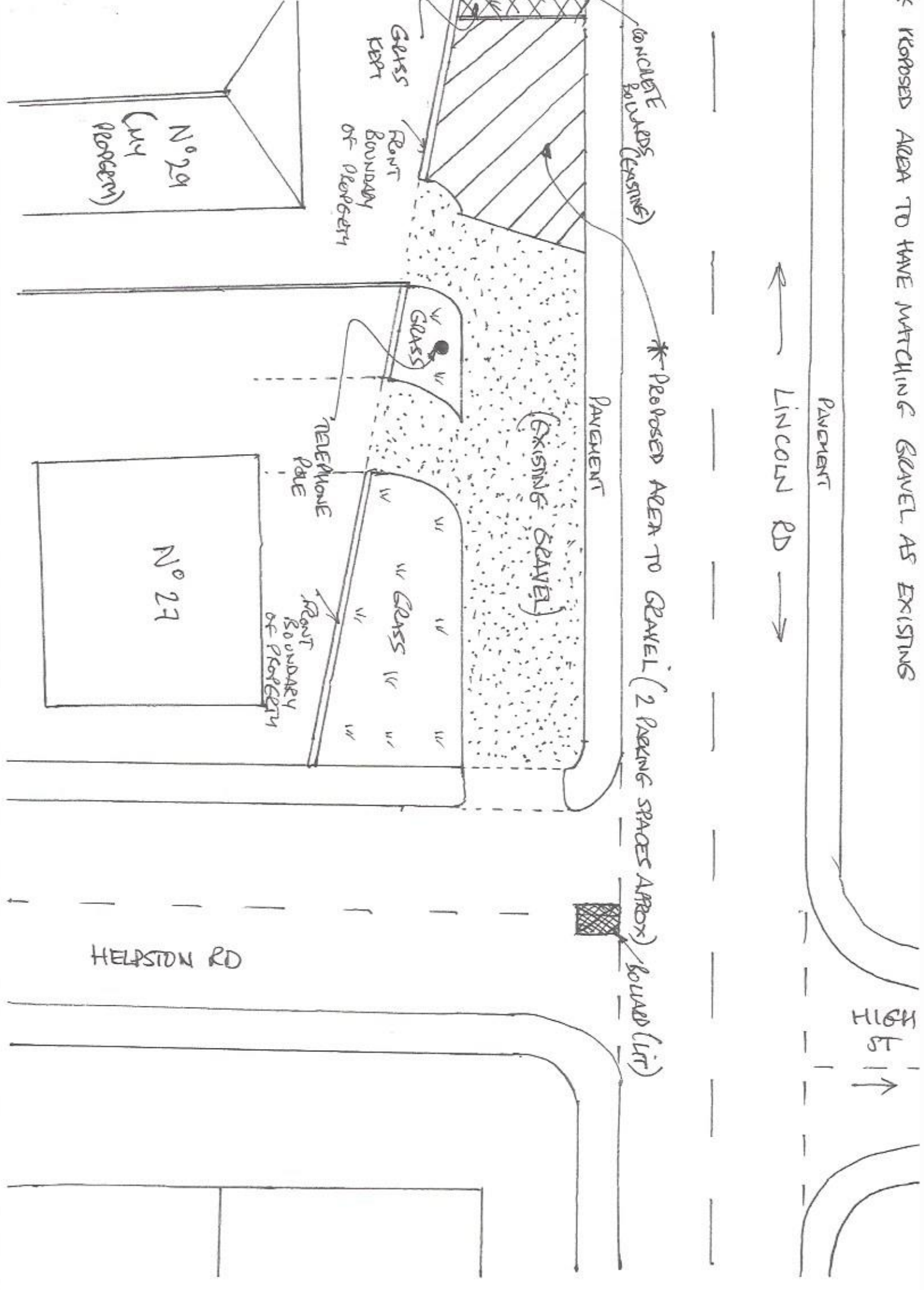
