

Peterborough Rural crime and information update – 1st to 31st March 2016

Please find enclosed reported crime and incidents of note during the period 1st- 31st March 2016. I have changed the format slightly so crimes and any relevant incidents can be reported. This report is intended to inform Parish Councils and their communities of issues they should be aware of and will not include incidents such as domestic violence or personal assault for example.

We have seen an increase this month of vehicles being targeted in rural roads – majority of which had been left unlocked and others with valuable items on display – we have sent out warning messages – leaving vehicles insecure is encouraging criminality to rural locations so please get the message out about locking cars and removing items if leaving overnight.

Northborough Ward (crimes and incidents of note)

- **Northborough** – burglary 6th March – report to police by confused elderly male under medical treatment – non crimed as visitors were carers
- **Deeping Gate** – 19th March – call by resident living on Market Deeping bypass that youths are tipping over bins put out for rubbish collection night before – no other calls received
- **Maxey** – High Street – overnight 24th March – report that dummy CCTV camera stolen from golf course – states on crime that cars gather here overnight but no further reports have been made in this regard.
- **Etton** – overnight 29th March – Woodcroft Road report that battery has been stolen from field nothing seen or heard

Glinton and Wittering Ward (crimes and incidents of note)

- **Ailsworth** – 5th March – one of a few calls this month about a male parking vehicle in Main Street and going off for some hours – been checked and all in order – rural crime team are aware.
- **Ailsworth** – 20th March – two outbuildings in garden Maffit Road entered by unknown persons – nothing appears to have been taken and scenes of crime were tasked to visit
- **Ailsworth** – 20th March – shed entered in garden Main Street – electrical items including computer stolen and scenes of crime have visited – both crimes filed at present and crime prevention advice has been given
- **Ailsworth** – between 16th and 23rd March – Main Street – glovebox and boot searched insecure vehicle
- **Castor** – overnight 15th March – Berrystead – theft reported from vehicle
- **Castor** – 15th March – Allotment Lane – theft from vehicle reported
- **Thornhaugh** – 13th March – calls to police about motorbikes getting access to the quarry area – Northants and Cambridgeshire Police are aware and will monitor on patrols
- **A1 Wansford and Wittering** – several reports this month of thefts from haulage lorries parked overnight in laybys on the A1 – the Roads Policing Unit are aware and pay passing attention when in area and we have advised the Haulage Association to warn drivers and given crime prevention advice.

- **Glington** – 20th March – burglary Scotts Road – report that items missing from property when left – crime of theft has been raised and investigated by detectives. No lines of enquiry so has been filed until more information comes to light

- **Eye** – Crowland Road 4th March, report of vehicle parked on verge – no restrictions in place Police did not attend

- **Eye** – Thorney Road, 4th March report of robbery at home – currently under investigation with team at Thorpe Wood
- **Eye** – Little Close, 7th March report of anti-social behaviour involving neighbours – advice on reporting further incidents given to both parties
- **Eye** – Whitby Avenue, overnight 14th March – theft reported from vehicle
- **Eye** – Waltham Avenue, overnight 16th March – theft reported from vehicle
- **Eye** – Hodney Road, 18th March report of bins left for collection being kicked over
- **Eye** – Bath Road, 27th March report of a burglary – items removed over two week period – currently being investigated
- **Thorney** – Station Road, 16th March – report of items stolen from works vehicle

- **Thorney** – Sandpit Road, 23rd March – report of possible distraction burglary elderly couple – currently under investigation – appears crime may not have occurred
